The research examines the intertwined transformations on the spatial and water arrangements of the urban landscape of the Veneto città diffusa (North-East Italy) occurred from the second post-war up to the recent economic crisis. Littered with mapping, redrawing, and conceptual diagrams, it shows how increased urbanization and agricultural intensification have led to the extension of water services networks and performing irrigation systems, together with loss of biodiversity, reduced permeability of the landscape and unexpected problems of drought, flooding, and pollution of water. In the search for resilience, the design exploration focuses on alternative decentralized arrangements of water showing how low-dense urbanization and heterogeneity of functions may prove strategic.
