

## ACADEMIC CAREER AND PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

In January 2011 I became associate professor at Università Roma Tre's Faculty of Economics, initially as a member of the Economics Department and, after the internal restructuring of the University, at the newly formed Business Studies Department.

From July 1st 1995 until 2010 I held a research position in the History of Economics (scientific-academic sector: SECS P/12) at the Faculty of Economics, Università Roma Tre.

In 1990 I was awarded a research grant to pursue a doctorate in Economic History through the Faculty of Economics and Commerce of the University of Bari, completing the Doctorate in 1993.

Also in 1990 I obtained a diploma in Archival Sciences at the School for Archival, Palaeographical and Diplomatic studies at the Rome State Archives.

In 1989 I was awarded a grant by the 'F. Datini' International Institute for the History of Economics, which allowed me to participate in the 11th 'F. Melis' Course for Specialisation in the History of Economics (held at Prato, 3rd - 15th April 1989).

## RESEARCH PROJECTS AND EDITORIAL ACTIVITY FOR SCIENTIFIC JOURNALS

I have participated in a number of research projects in Italy including the project, co-financed by MURST (2005), on *Territorial organisation and economic and social transformations in the Ostiense-Testaccio area from the early Medieval period to the Modern era*, coordinated by Professor C.M. Travaglini (Università degli Studi Roma Tre).

From 1993 to 1995 I collaborated in the project for the archival reorganisation, analytical filing and transferal onto optical support of the documents contained in the IRI Historical Archive housed in the Rome Research Consortium.

From 1993 I have collaborated with the interdisciplinary journal 'Roma Moderna e Contemporanea', first as editorial secretary and later as scientific correspondent.

Since 2014 I have been a member of the editorial committee of the journal 'Research on Economic and Social History'.

I am a referee for the journals 'Città e Storia', 'Storia e problemi Contemporanei', 'Dimensioni e problemi della Ricerca Storica'; I have worked as proofreader on SIR 2014 projects for the Ministry for Education, Universities and Research.

## ORGANISATION OF CULTURAL EVENTS AND CONVENTION SESSIONS

In the period January-May 2015 I curated the scientific section of the exhibition entitled *The Economy at War*, organised by the 'Pierangelo Garegnani' economic-legal section of the Roma Tre library, during which various seminars were presented.

I organised the panel *Production, Trade and Business organisation in the Dairy sector between early industrialisation and Globalisation* at the XVII<sup>th</sup> World Economic History Congress, *Diversity in Development* (Kyoto, 3rd-7th August 2015), together with Claudio Besana, Francesco Chiapparino and Silvia Conca).

I organised the panels *La France et l'Italie Formagère: une comparaison entre économies et territoires (1870-2000)* and *La qualité pour la loi? Les produits italiens au XX siècle*, which were presented, respectively, at the Première Conférence International d'Histoire et de Cultures de l'alimentation (Tours 25th-26th March 2015) and at the Deuxième Conférence Internationale d'histoire et des cultures de l'alimentation (Tours 26th-27th May 2016), together with Silvia Conca, Claudio Besana, and Sylvie Vabre.

I was a member of the scientific committee of the Convention *Food and Culture*, whose scientific director was Giovanna Motta (Roma, Università La Sapienza, 9th-11th June 2016).
