SUMMARY

Francesca Iannelli is Associate Professor at the Roma Tre University in Italy, where she lectures on Aesthetics, History of Aesthetics, Philosophy of Music, Philosophy and Semiotics of Taste, Didactics of Philosophy.

She studied Philosophy at the University of Rome La Sapienza (1991-1997) and obtained her German-Italian Ph.D. from the FernUniversität Hagen and the University of Roma Tre (2004). She was Scientific fellow worker (wissenschaftliche Hilfskraft) at the Department of Philosophy of the FernUniversität Hagen (1997-98; 1999-2001). Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the Deutsches Literaturarchiv (DLA) in Marbach (2010), DAAD Research Fellow at the Humboldt Universität Berlin (2015) and Izea Research Fellow at the Martin Luther Universität Halle. With Alain Patrick Olivier (Nantes University, France) she coordinates Hegel Art Net, an international community of scholars working on the edition and translation of Hegel's lectures on "Philosophy of Art". The research concerns as well the reception of Hegel's philosophy in the contemporary debates and in the current artistic creation all over the world.
