RESUMÉ

FRANCESCA IANNELLI is Full Professor at Roma Tre University, where she teaches Aesthetics (LT, 6 CFU), Aesthetics of German Idealism, Philosophy and Semiotics of Taste (LT, 6 CFU) and Philosophy Teaching (LM, 6 CFU).

She studied Philosophy at the University of Rome La Sapienza (1991-1997) and obtained an Italian-German PhD in Philosophy from FernUniversität Hagen and Roma Tre University (2004). She was a research assistant (*wissenschaftliche Hilfskraft*) at the Department of Philosophy at FernUniversität Hagen (1997-98; 1999-2001). She was a postdoctoral fellow at the Deutsches Literaturarchiv (DLA) in Marbach (2010), a DAAD fellow at Humboldt Universität Berlin (2015), and an IZEA fellow at Martin Luther Universität Halle.

Since 2019, she has been coordinating *Hegel Art Net* with Alain Patrick Olivier (University of Nantes, France), an international network of scholars working on the edition and translation of Hegel's Lectures on the Philosophy of Art. The network's research also focuses on the reception of Hegel's philosophy
